shopping list:

- Coat – whatever pleases your fancy, something warm, & wool, peacoat is good, mid-length
 - Charcoal grey (maybe a faint pattern?), navy, or black
- Dress Shirts – "executive shirts"
 - Try slim fits
 - Subtle patterns, checks, stripes, texture
 - Some colors to think about:
 - jewel tones: dark teal, wine, dark purple, navy
- Casual Shirts – "cool kid shirts"
 - Solid with texture, soft washes, oxfords, denim
 - Plaids, square plaid/large gingham, thin stripes
- Sweaters
 - V-neck, crew neck, shawl collar
 - Merino wool is light weight; cotton blends
 - Solid colors, maybe a stripe?
- Non-jeans
 - Different meanings for different stores
 - Theory makes great slacks
 - J. Crew, Banana, Gap will have good chinos in variety of colors
 - Think about grey (light grey and darker grey, slate grey)
 - Diesel & Levi's will have jeans that look like non-jeans, and trendy cool kid non-jeans
- Jeans
 - Levi's: try on the 511 and 514. 514 will prob fit perfect.
 - Watch out for excessive/apparent whiskering around crotch
- Shoes
 - Refer to style sheet
 - Clarks!
 - Timberland may have good cool dress shoes and boots
- Bags
 - Take a peek in the stores listed and see if you like anything
 - Look for waxed cotton, distressed leather, or combo of both
